1 On June 9, 2009, Plaintiffs Leon Hillman, Craig Tucker, David Bitts, Karuk Tribe,  
2 Center for Biological Diversity, Friends of the River, Klamath Riverkeeper, Pacific Coast  
3 Federation of Fishermen's Associations, Institute for Fisheries Resources, and California  
4 Sportfishing Protection Alliance (collectively, "Plaintiffs"), sought a Motion for Preliminary  
5 Injunction enjoining the Defendants California Department of Fish and Game and Donald Koch,  
6 Director ("Defendants") from spending any funds allocated from the State of California's  
7 General Fund on any activities which allow suction dredge mining to occur under the  
8 Department's current regulations (14 California Code of Regulations ("CCR") §§228, 228.5)  
9 until the Plaintiffs case is heard on its merits.

11 After consideration of Plaintiffs' Notice and Motion, Plaintiffs' Memorandum of Points  
12 and Authorities in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction; the Declaration of  
13 Lynne R. Saxton in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction; the Proposed  
14 Order, and all other papers and pleadings on file in this action, GOOD CAUSE having been  
15 shown, I hereby ORDER:

17 That Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction is GRANTED and Defendants are  
18 enjoined from spending any funds allocated from the State of California's General Fund on any  
19 activities which allow suction dredge mining to occur under the Department's current regulations  
20 (14 CCR §§228, 228.5) until the Plaintiffs case is heard on its merits.
